Hawai'i Pacific University offers a limited number of tuition-waiver scholarships to graduate students who plan to enroll in a master's program at the University. The scholarships and assistantships are applicable to fall and spring semesters only, and do not apply to HPU's summer and winter sessions.

Value of Scholarship:

Scholarships range from 20% – 50% tuition waivers, renewable each year until completion of a degree, as long as the student is in good academic standing. Students awarded a graduate assistantship will be required to work 10 hours per week on campus during each semester.

Types of Awards:

- **Trustee's Scholarship** – 50% tuition waiver.
- **Dean's Scholarship** – 20% tuition waiver.
- **Graduate Assistantship** – 50% tuition waiver and recipients are required to work 10 hours per week during each academic semester.
- **International Scholar** – 20% - 50% tuition waiver.

Minimum Eligibility:

Eligible applicants are new full- or part-time degree-seeking students who have applied directly to the University, submitted a complete admissions application, and have been accepted to the University.

Note: The notification letter provides details of the award.

Application Process:

The following documents must be submitted directly to the Graduate Admissions Office in order to be considered for a graduate scholarship:

1. A completed HPU Application for Admissions form.
2. A completed Scholarship Application.

We encourage you to apply for the earliest possible submission date.

Priority Deadlines (applications will be reviewed according to the date submitted):

Fall Semester: All materials must be postmarked by February 1st, March 1st, or April 1st.

Spring Semester: All materials must be postmarked by September 1st or October 1st.

Applications received after the priority deadline will be awarded on a funds-available basis.
